The Koru Games is a multi-day, multi-sport tournament hosted in Selwyn District for South Island Year 7 & 8 children. **This tournament is an optional activity that will cost children \$37 to attend over the three days. This will cover transport (provided by parent helpers) to and from Rolleston by car and entry fees.** Petrol money will be reimbursed to parents providing transport at a rate \$6 per student per day.

This three day tournament will provide participants with the chance to further their sporting endeavours within a competitive yet 'Fair Play' conscious environment. The sports to be included in 2017 are Badminton, Basketball, Football Lawn Bowls, Netball, Rugby Sevens, Table Tennis, Tennis, Touch and Volleyball. **Details for each sport are on the back of this notice.** All sports will be hosted at Selwyn District venues. Our entries are dependent on numbers for each sport.

# Sport Specific Information

## **Badminton**

### **Venue – Lincoln Events Centre**

The badminton competition will consist of separate boys and girls competitions, playing two singles and a doubles game per match. Each squad can have a maximum of four members.

## **Basketball**

### **Venue – Lincoln University Rec Centre**

The basketball competition will consist of separate boys and girls competitions playing 3-ball, three on three, half-court basketball. Each squad can have a maximum of five members.

## **Football**

### **Venue – Prebbleton Domain**

The football competition will consist of separate boys and girls competitions playing nine a side football. Each squad can have a maximum of 12 members.

## **Lawn Bowls**

### **Venues – Lincoln Bowling Club (adjacent to Netball & Rugby Sevens)**

The lawn bowls competition will consist of separate boys, girls and mixed competitions, playing pairs bowls on an artificial green. Each squad will consist of two members.

## **Netball**

### **Venue – Selwyn Netball Centre (adjacent to Lawn Bowls & Rugby Sevens)**

The netball competition will consist of a girls competition only playing seven aside netball. Boys are permitted to play within a girls team, provided there is no more than one boy in each of the circle or midcourt positions at any one time. Each squad can have a maximum of 10 members.

## **Rugby Sevens**

### **Venue – Lincoln Rugby Football Club (adjacent to Lawn Bowls & Netball)**

The rugby sevens competition will consist of separate boys and girls competitions, playing seven aside rugby sevens. Girls are permitted to play within a boys team. Each squad can have a maximum of 12 members.

## **Table Tennis**

### **Venue – Rolleston Community Centre**

The table tennis competition will consist of separate boys, girls and mixed competitions, playing matches consisting of one doubles and two singles games. Each squad can have of a maximum of four members.

## **Tennis**

### **Venue – Prebbleton Tennis Club, Prebbleton Reserve**

The tennis competition will consist of separate boys, girls and mixed competitions, playing doubles only. Each squad will consist of two members.

## **Touch**

### **Venue – Rolleston Rugby Club, Rolleston Reserve**

The touch competition will consist of separate boys, girls and mixed competitions playing six a side touch. Each squad can have a maximum of 14 members.

## **Volleyball**

### **Venue – Lincoln University Fields**

The volleyball competition will consist of separate boys and girls competitions playing four a side, outdoor volleyball. Each squad can have a maximum of six members
