Kia ora Parents / Whānau

In Week 8, Thursday 14th September, we have our Library visit, performing at 10am, and then performing at our Art Soiree in the evening.

For the morning performance we will be travelling to the Library on buses and will require a small payment of for this trip. The group will not be performing in uniform for this event. We are aware that some Year 7 and 8 children will be at technology that morning - because it is only a short visit, these students will not be attending the library and are not required to pay for transport for this event.

That evening, for the Arts Soiree, we ask that students arrive at school, in the Mahuri Kowhai area at **6pm** to allow us time to get everyone dressed in their uniforms and ready to perform. We ask that girls have their hair tied half-up, half-down, and that you wear black tights (short) for underneath your dress. Some may want to wear a plain black singlet also. Boys will be wearing shorts and all children will be in barefeet. We will come back to the Mahuri Kowhai area after we perform to get dressed. Children are free to be picked up at the conclusion of the Art Soiree event.

In Week 10 we are attending the Rakahuri Festival at Ohoka hall. Rather than making two payments for transport to the Library and Ohoka Hall we ask that you pay for both (if your child is attending both of these) at the same time.

Each return bus trip is \$4 making a total of \$8 payable via Kindo before Monday 11th September.

Your tamariki have been working hard on their performance piece and we hope to see you at the Soiree to support them.
